A. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Before a student can register successfully for a PhD, a full Research Proposal, and corresponding Executive Summary, have to be approved by a Candidature Panel. Students who qualify for this are those who already hold a Master's degree, as well as current Master's students who have been identified by their supervisor(s) as having the potential to be converted to a PhD.

As a member of the panel, you are requested to evaluate these documents in terms of the set of requirements below.

If the process is part of an application for a conversion from a Master's degree to a PhD (indicated in the covering letter which accompanies the set of documents you received, as well as in the project details above), you are asked additionally to evaluate the conversion in a separate section, according to the given set of requirements. An oral evaluation will be scheduled after receipt of your evaluation form.

In addition to completing the form, you are invited to provide free-form written comments, which you can submit together with this form. This is not mandatory, but is helpful in cases where the student needs to resubmit the proposal. Alternatively, a commented copy of the proposal may also be submitted.

B. EVALUATION: CONVERSION TO PhD (if applicable)
